- Negotiate labor agreement for:

 - Laborers' Local 341 & 942
 - Plasterers & Cement Masons Local 528
 - Operating Engineers Local 302
 - Roofers, Waterproofers & Allied Workers Local 189
 - Western States Regional Council of Carpenters
- Educate AGC members about labor relations issues.
- Work with AGC members to resolve labor relations issues.
- Hold regular meetings to share information.
