We also wanted to create a record of the many workforce development success stories shared during the summit. And we wanted to capture the many ideas summit participants crafted during the sessions focused on overcoming various workforce challenges.

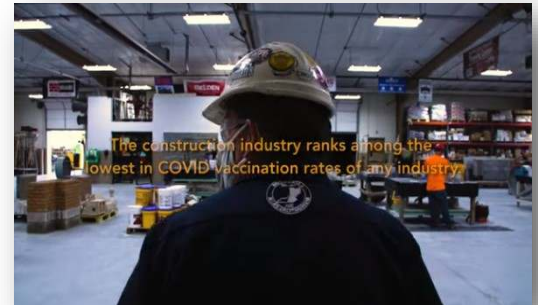
